Risk Management Framework (RMF) Course

Course Overview: The Risk Management Framework (RMF) course is an intensive 4-day, hands-on training experience led by seasoned Information Security and Technology professionals. It provides the student with a broad understanding of IS security policy, principles, rules, and procedures. The course is based on the three principal guidelines for Department of Defense (DoD) and Intelligence Community IS security: ICD 503/Risk Management Framework; Joint Special Access Program Implementation Guide (JSIG); and Risk Management Framework for DoD Information Technology. Students who complete this course will gain the skills, policy familiarity, and technical understanding necessary to perform the daily job functions for implementing RMF.

Course Goal: The goal of this course is to provide knowledge and skills to ISSMs, ISSOs, ISSEs, and Assessors responsible for implementing and assessing security policies, practices, and technologies in accordance with Risk Management Framework, JSIG, IC, and DoD Guidance.

- Identify the Roles and Responsibilities in the RMF process and the Six RMF steps
- Discuss Impact Values and Authorization Artifacts/Body of Evidence Required
- Explore Administrative and Non-Technical Security Features as well as Technical Security Features
- Examine Risk Management Philosophy
- Observe how Continuous Monitoring impacts RMF
